The recognized scholarship recipient will have demonstrated their commitment to promoting a positive understanding of the LGBTQ community to the greater community.

Applicants will be eligible for a **\$500** Scholarship and it will be made available after verification of acceptance and enrollment to a post-secondary institution.

Qualifications:

- 1) Applicant must be graduating from an accredited High School in the Southern Tier of New York or have received their GED. (Southern Tier is considered Broome or Tioga County)
- 2) Applicant must be actively involved in either a School Sanctioned GSA or another LGBTQ organization during secondary school. (Church, School, Community organization)

Process:

Interested Applicants will complete and return the application with two letters of recommendation by **April 15, 2019**.

Letters of Recommendations must contain contact information for the person writing the recommendation. An application will not be considered without the letters of recommendation.

A copy of the most recent high school transcript or report card should accompany the application as well.
